At The Dog School dogs are boarded in a group living situation. Dogs have free access in and out of the house and fenced yard. This allows for many benefits to the dog such as playtime with other dogs, a comfortable house to train and visit in, numerous training opportunities, and exposure to all sorts of people.

Dogs are not kept in concrete and chain link runs as is common in traditional boarding facilities. Our boarding environment does pose some risks, which may not occur in a facility where the dogs are kept isolated from one another. We do not expect problems to occur, but regardless, want to inform owners of some of the possibilities. Please know we take every precaution to avoid these problems, but we cannot guarantee they won't occur.

1. Dogs playing in groups are similar to children on a playground.  
Like a skinned knee, dogs may get puncture wounds while playing with other dogs.
2. If one dog gets a cold, all the dogs can get it. This is most commonly seen as conjunctivitis (eye infection) or kennel cough (the vaccine will not prevent all strains of kennel cough).
3. The yard is a huge grassy and wooded area. Dogs are capable of digging or climbing and escaping the yard.

Because this is a *home* boarding environment and the dogs live with people and other dogs, we cannot board aggressive dogs or dogs that bark excessively. If your dog acts aggressively, we will contact your emergency number to arrange for immediate, alternative care. If your dog barks a lot, we will try a no

bark citronella collar on your dog. This is painless and is effective about 80% of the time. If your dog continues to bark we will contact your emergency number to arrange for immediate, alternative care.
